• Why do you think more people are heading to the Maldives during shoulder season?

• What are some advantages (beyond saving money) to going in shoulder season?

The Maldives can be quite busy during peak season (December to March), when tourists from colder regions flock to escape winter. The shoulder season offers a quieter experience, which is ideal for those who want a more private and peaceful beach and excursion experience with fewer visitors.

Shoulder season also coincides with favourable underwater conditions for activities like diving and snorkelling. For example, April and May are known for whale shark and manta ray sightings. The relatively calm seas and excellent water visibility make it an attractive time for marine enthusiasts.

• Are there certain atolls and resorts which are especially great for shoulder season?

Several atolls and resorts in the Maldives are particularly advantageous during shoulder season. The South Ari Atoll is a standout, featuring esteemed resorts such as <u>Lux south</u> <u>Ari atoll</u> and <u>Lily Beach Resort & Spa</u> on Huvahendhoo Island. <u>Vilamendhoo</u>, one of the islands as part of Alif Dhaal Atoll, is also a great option. These regions have exceptional underwater marine biodiversity, making it a prime destination for diving and snorkelling enthusiasts.

These resorts not only provide the R&R which customers look for in a Maldivian holiday but also offer a range of water activities and access to vibrant house reefs. Strategically located in areas known for rich marine life, they enhance opportunities for wildlife encounters during shoulder season. This combination of tranquillity and adventure positions these atolls as ideal choices for customers looking to maximise their experience in the Maldives.

• Within shoulder season, what are the cheapest months?

The most affordable months to visit the Maldives during shoulder season are September and October. These months generally feature lower rates on accommodations and travel, allowing savvy customers to experience this idyllic destination without breaking the bank.

However, it's important to note that prices may rise around the mid-October half-term holiday, particularly during the peak week. By planning trips either earlier in September or after this peak period in late October, travellers can take full advantage of the budget-friendly options while still enjoying the stunning beauty and unique offerings of the Maldives.
